Course components	Description
Pre-test	The pre-test is designed to assess your knowledge of the subject matter prior to viewing the lesson. You have one attempt and must take the pre-test before viewing the lesson.
Lesson Materials	This training consists of three self-paced lessons and one 2-day live class. Learners must complete Lesson One and Lesson Two prior to registering for the live class. After the live class, learners return online to complete Lesson Three and course evaluations – a code will be provided at the end of the live class to access these. Please note the technical requirements for viewing the lesson provided in Moodle.
Post-test	The post-test is designed to assess your knowledge of the subject matter once you have completed the lesson. You have unlimited attempts to complete this assessment. Passing grade is 70%.
Course evaluation	All course evaluations are completely anonymous and help us to make any improvements, if necessary, to the course. You must submit the evaluation before accessing your credit and Certificate of Completion.
Claim Credit	Once you have completed all the course components, you will be directed to the BU CME/CNE website to claim credit and access your Certificate of Completion. You should download the Certificate to keep a copy. A copy will always be available in your BU CME/CNE account.
